# QUALITY OF LIFE

### **Health Care**

- The Buchanan County Medical Center has 144 beds and offers a full range of medical care along with 11 clinics and 2 nursing homes. There are 22 physicians and 6 dentists.

### **Hotels/Meeting Rooms**

 There are four motels located within the County. One facility offers meeting rooms.

### Libraries

- The Buchanan County Library has a branch in Grundy with over 72,000 volumes.

### Recreation/Culture

- The Clinch Mountain Wildlife Areas and the Breaks Interstate Park offer numerous outdoor recreational opportunities.
- Buchanan County maintains recreational facilities including 18 tennis courts, two horse rinks, four swimming pools, 11 softball fields and a 9-hole golf course.
- Organized community recreational programs are available year round for the entire family.
- The New Mountain Players, a theater group, and numerous arts and craft festivals, provide cultural entertainment throughout the year.

### Religion

- There are over 100 churches in the county representing most Protestant and the Roman Catholic faiths.

### Commercial Air Service

Tri-Cities Regional Airport in Blountville, Tennessee, is approximately 100 miles from Buchanan County. Airline service available through U.S. Air, Delta/Atlantic Southeast Airlines (ASA), Northwest Airlink and Allegiant Air.

### General Aviation Service

Grundy Airport offers a 2,350 foot runway. Tazewell County Airport at Claypool Hill is within 25 miles of Grundy and offers a 4,300 foot runway.
